## Leading Through Crisis: A Masterclass



Celebrating Teacher's Day



## **RECIPE - FOR CHICKEN BIRYANI**

#### **Ingredients:**

- 2 cups basmati rice
- 500g chicken, cut into pieces
- 1 cup yogurt
- 2 large onions, thinly sliced
- 2 tomatoes, chopped
- 1/4 cup cooking oil or ghee
- 2 teaspoons ginger-garlic paste
- 1 teaspoon turmeric powder
- 1 teaspoon turmeric powder
- 1 teaspoon red chili powder

- 1 teaspoon turmeric powder
- 1 teaspoon red chili powder
- 1 teaspoon garam masala
- 1 teaspoon cumin seeds
- 4-5 green cardamom pods
- 4-5 cloves
- 2-inch cinnamon stick
- 1 bay leaf
- Salt to taste
- Fresh coriander and mint leaves for garnish

#### **Instructions:**

1. Wash and soak basmati rice in water for 30

minutes. Cook the rice until it's 70-80% done, then drain excess water.

- 2. In a separate pan, heat oil or ghee. Add cumin seeds, cardamom, cloves, cinnamon, and bay leaf. Sauté for a minute.
- 3. Add sliced onions and cook until golden brown. Remove half for garnishing.
- 4. Add ginger-garlic paste and sauté until the raw smell disappears.
- 5. Add chicken pieces and cook until they're no longer pink. Add turmeric, red chili powder, and salt.
- 6. Mix in chopped tomatoes and cook until they are soft. Add yogurt and cook until the chicken is tender.
- 7. In a large pot, layer half of the partially cooked rice, followed by the chicken mixture. Repeat the layers.
- 8. Sprinkle garam masala, fried onions, and chopped coriander/mint on top.
- 9. Cover and cook on low heat for 15-20 minutes, allowing the flavours to meld and the rice to fully cook.
- 10. Gently mix before serving. Garnish with more fresh herbs if desired.


